

Subject: LOCAL RULE ON HOUSEHOLD INCOME LIMITS FOR FEDERAL NON-PROFIT SECTION 95 PROJECTS ONLY

Background:

Under the Social Housing Reform Act 2000 (SHRA), Ontario transferred its responsibilities for federal programs to the City of London as Service Manager. It is the Service Manager's responsibility to ensure that these programs are administered according to the existing Operating Agreements with individual federal housing providers, as well as applicable legislation.

Table 4 of 368/01 identifies the rules and criteria for transferred housing programs such as the non-profit 2% write-down program and states "the income of a household, at the time of its selection to reside in a rent-geared-to-income unit, shall not exceed the applicable household income limit". These household income limits are established as the responsibility of the Service Manager.

The **Household Income Limits** as per O. Reg. 298/01, Section 8 and O. Reg. 368/01 S. 6, be adopted as noted below:
