This study includes an assessment of the potential need to widen the existing transmission main easement to continue ongoing monitoring of the condition of the watermain and/or for potential maintenance, repair or replacement of the existing watermain. Long term considerations include evaluating the alternative options for routing the watermain between the Arva Pumping Station and Huron Street in total or for specific sections. The routing options to be investigated will address long term transmission capacity needs and provide for redundancy.

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
