## **Building Division update**

## April 17, 2021

The following is an update related to the status of Building Division services. In the event of a conflict between this update and provincial regulation, the regulation shall govern.

Effective **April 17, 2021** ,considering the possibility of an extension as the situation evolves:

#### PERMIT APPLICATIONS

No change to permit application submissions. These continue to be accepted digitally only and processed.

# **BUILDING/PLUMBING/FIRE PROTECTION INSPECTIONS ("Inspections")**

- 1. The Building Division will continue to provide inspections with respect to **all RESIDENTIAL** construction projects.
- 2. Inspections will continue to be conducted under a building permit for work associated with **INSTITUTIONAL** construction or demolition projects and services associated with:
  - the healthcare sector and long-term care, including new facilities, expansions, renovations and conversion of spaces that could be repurposed for health care space, regardless of the date the permit was issued.
  - projects that support the operations of, and provide new capacity in schools, colleges, universities, or child care centres within the meaning of the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014.
- Inspections will continue to be conducted for work associated with an INDUSTRIAL building permit for construction or demolition activities required for,
  - the maintenance and operations of petrochemical plants and refineries,
  - significant industrial petrochemical projects where preliminary work has commenced before April 17, 2021 under a building permit.
  - industrial construction and modifications to existing industrial structures limited solely to work necessary for the production, maintenance, and/or enhancement of Personal Protective Equipment, medical devices such as ventilators, and other identified products directly related to combatting the COVID-19 pandemic.

- projects or activities that would provide additional capacity in the production, processing, manufacturing or distribution of food, beverages or agricultural products.
- 4. Inspections will continue to be conducted for construction work associated with any INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL, INSTITUTIONAL or RESIDENTIAL permits for construction or demolition activities required for:
  - construction projects and services required to ensure safe and reliable operations of, or to provide new capacity in,
    - (i) municipal infrastructure, or
    - (ii) provincial infrastructure, including but not limited to, the transit, transportation, resource, energy and justice sectors;
  - the supporting operations of providing new capacity in, electricity generation, transmission, distribution and storage, natural gas distribution, transmission and storage or in the supply of resources.
  - construction projects and services that support the operations of broadband internet and cellular technologies and services.
  - construction projects that were commenced before <u>April 17, 2021</u>, under a building permit, and that would:
    - i. provide additional capacity for businesses that provide logistical support, distribution services, warehousing, storage or shipping and delivery services, or
    - ii. provide additional capacity in the operation and delivery of Information Technology (IT) services or telecommunications services.
    - iii. provide additional capacity to, or enhance the efficiency or operations of, businesses that extract, manufacture, process and distribute goods, products, equipment and materials.
  - construction projects funded in whole or in part under
    - (i) the Crown in right of Canada or in right of Ontario.
    - (ii) an agency of the Crown in right of Canada or in right of Ontario, or
    - (iii) a municipality.
  - construction related to utilities infrastructure (site servicing).
  - intended to provide shelter or supports for vulnerable persons or affordable housing, and
    - (ii) being funded in whole or in part by, or are being undertaken by,
      - (A) the Crown in right of Canada or in right of Ontario,
      - (B) an agency of the Crown in right of Canada or in right of Ontario,
      - (C) a municipality,
      - (D) a service manager as defined the Housing Services Act, 2011,

- (E) a registered charity within the meaning of the *Income Tax Act* (Canada), or
- (F) a not-for-profit corporation.
- 5. Inspections will not be conducted for construction or demolition activities not listed in pars. (1), (2), (3), or (4) above.

### PERMITS & INSPECTIONS FOR SIGNS, POOL FENCES, AND WORK APPROVALS

Permit processing for the following, continues and remains unchanged:

- Work Approval Permits
- Move/Heavy Load Permits
- Sign permits
- Swimming Pool Fence Permits
- Lawyers' Letters
- Zoning Compliance Letters

<u>Please note: All inspections for SIGN construction/erection have been suspended</u>, unless associated with construction activities identified in pars. (1), (2), (3), or (4).
