ABSENCES The resident and those they are with must always wear Surgical/Medical mask (as tolerated for the resident) and must practice social distancing and wash hands often. Residents will be actively screened on return. Upon return from overnight absences, resident will be PCR tested and isolated according to the requirements in Directive #3 from the government.
