Significance: Understanding the number of census families in private households with children within a Planning District can help to inform the concentration of young children within the Planning District, and therefore the potential demand for early learning and licensed child care services in the area.

**Definition:** The average household income after taxes for the previous year.

**Definition:** The percentage of the labor force that is self-reported as unemployed.

#### % OF POP. WITH NO CERT., DIPLOMA, DEGREE (INC. HIGH SCHOOL)

Definition: Percentage of the population without any formal education credentials.

As of: May 2021

Significance: May correlate with employment opportunities and income levels, potentially affecting the demand for additional early learning and licensed child care opportunities across the City, as well as the potential demand for child care fee subsidization.
